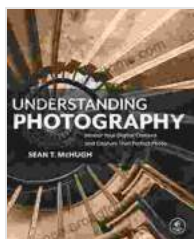

LEADING LINES

The lines in this picture serve as a guide that lead your eyes to the subject of the photo



DEPTH OF FIELD

This is when the subject of the photo is completely in focus and the background is blurry. This can be controlled by a person



SHUTTER SPEED & APERTURE

These figures are on your SLR camera (keep the higher the number (1/400) the faster the shutter speed. You are able to shoot faster subjects. As your aperture number gets lower (f/2.8) more light is allowed into the lens. Wide light allows you to shoot in low light situations.



FRAMING

This is when there are objects around the subject that draw the subject making your eyes more drawn to it.



BALANCE

Having your main subject off center, as with the rule of thirds, creates a more interesting photo. The result balances the "weight" of your subject by introducing another subject of lesser importance to fill the space.



VIEW POINT

Before shooting your subject, think about where you will shoot it from. The view point has a major effect on the composition of a photo, and it can greatly affect the message that the photo conveys.

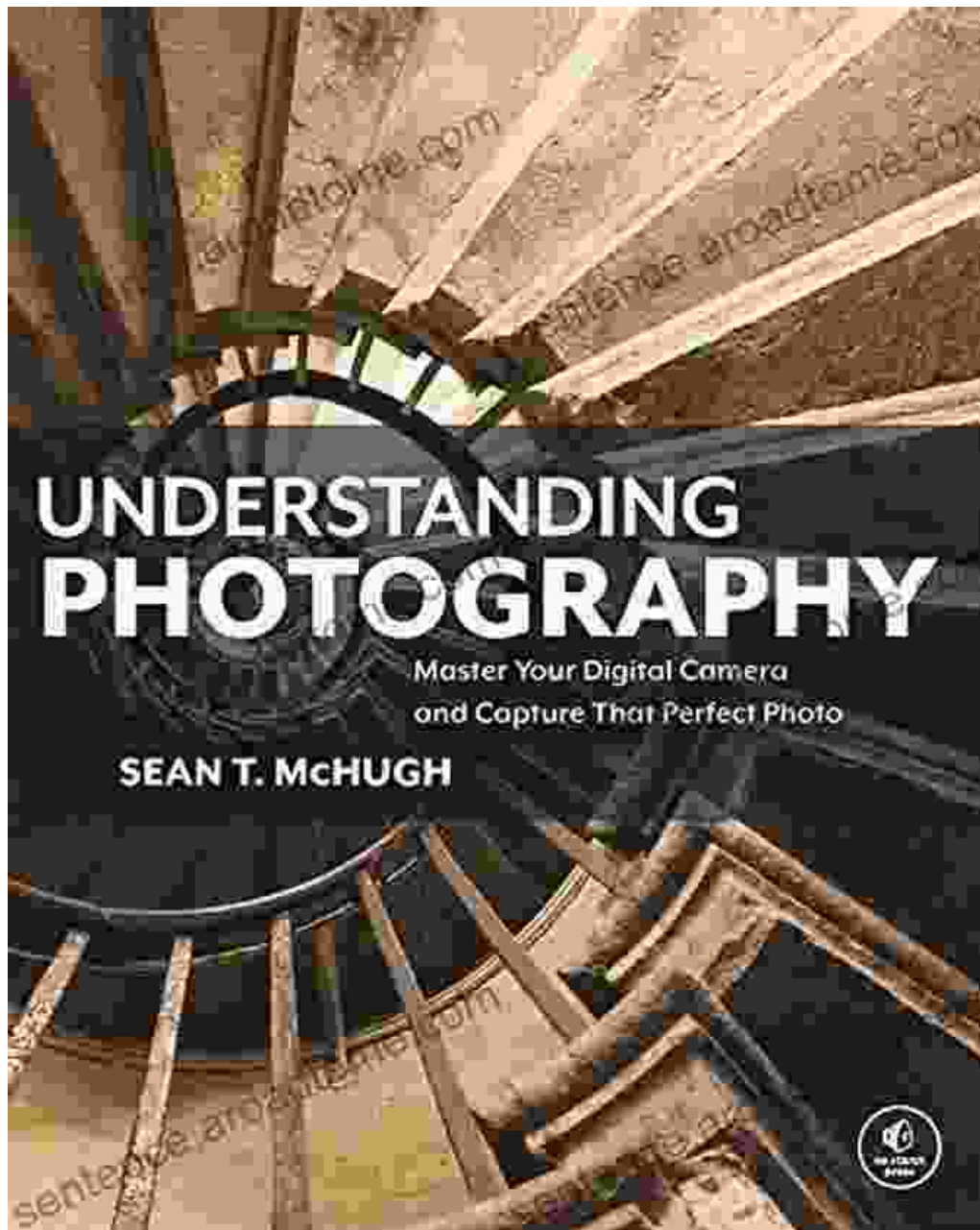


SYMMETRY

This is when the photo is equally balanced or has a mirror creating symmetry within the photo. This can be any sort of thing, particularly in situations where they are not expected.

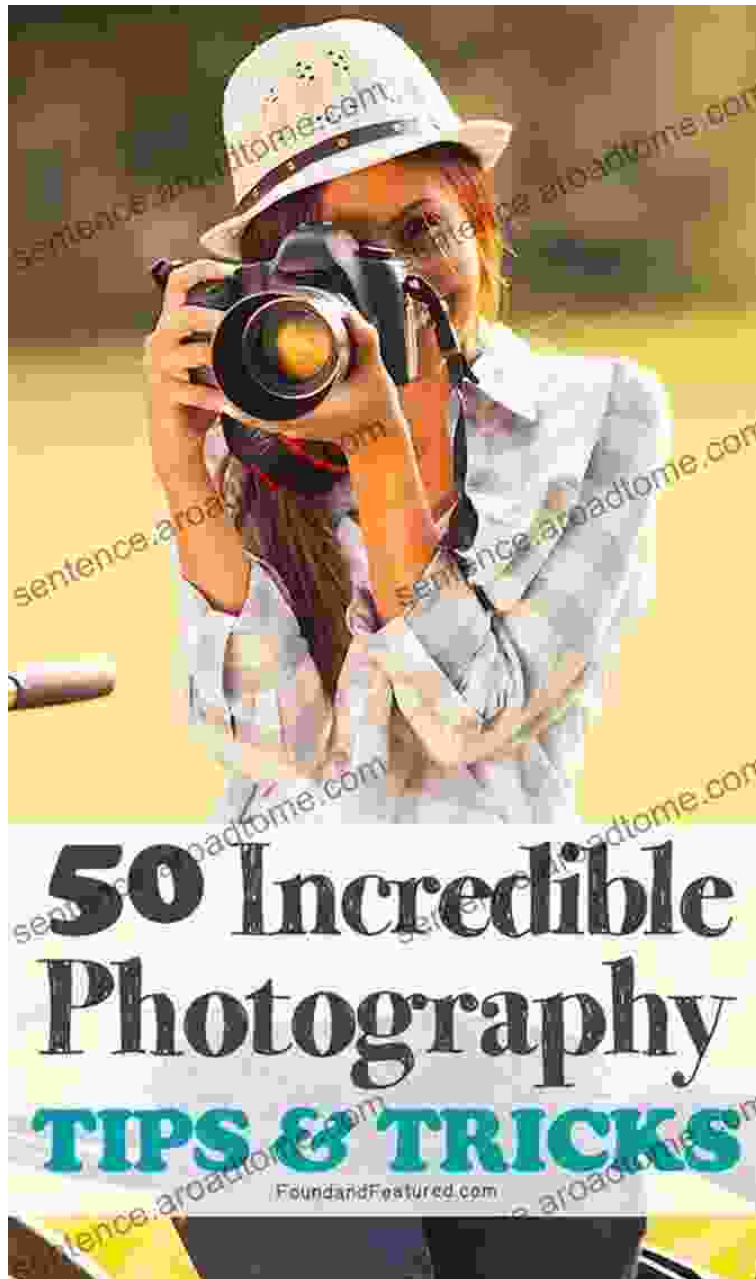

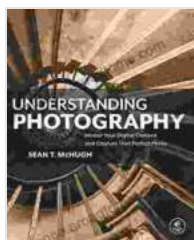

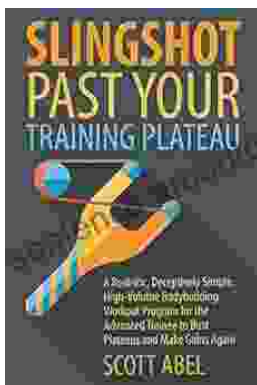
