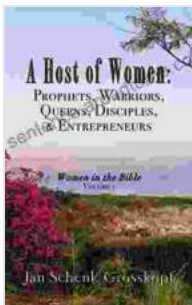

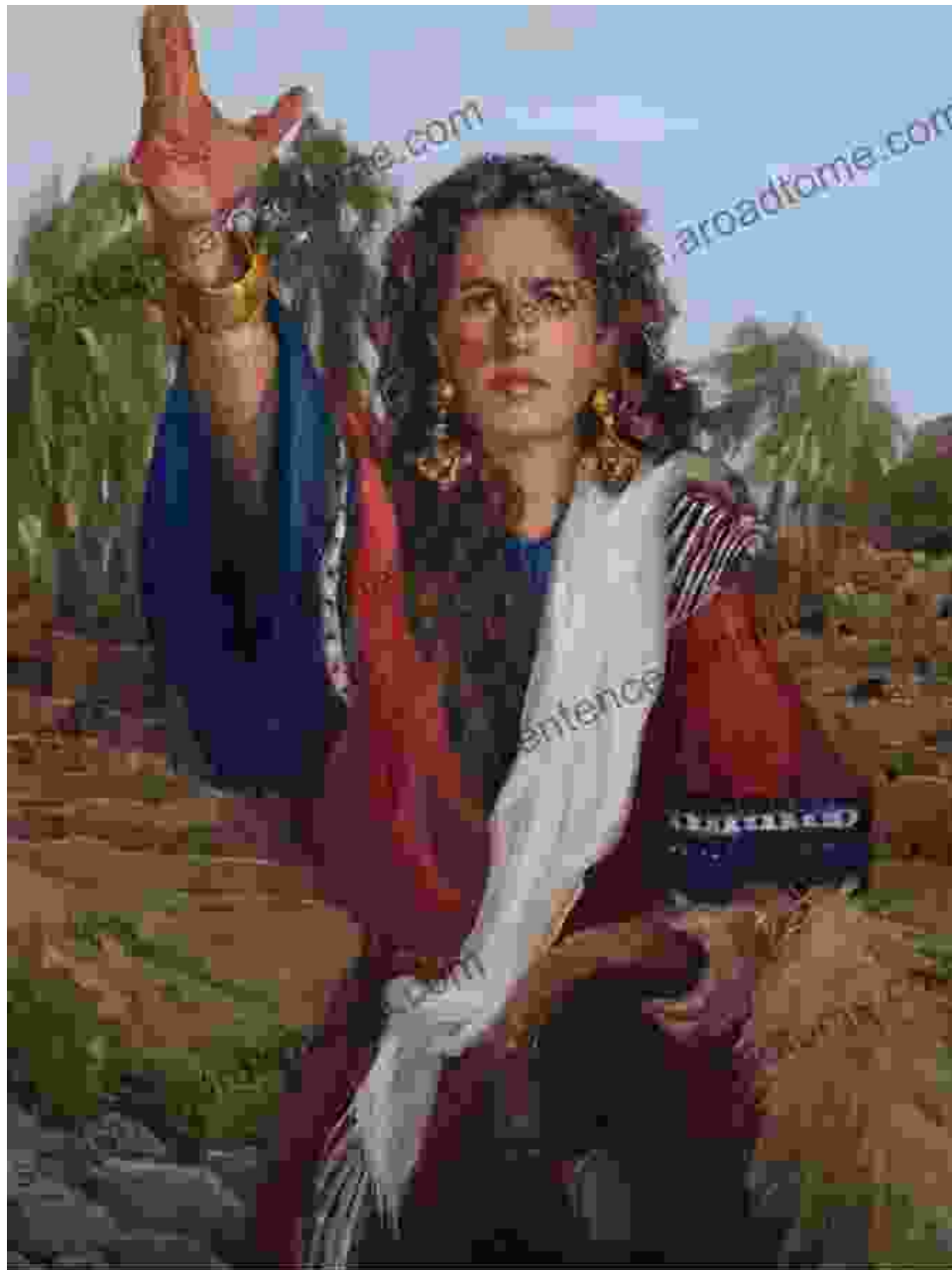

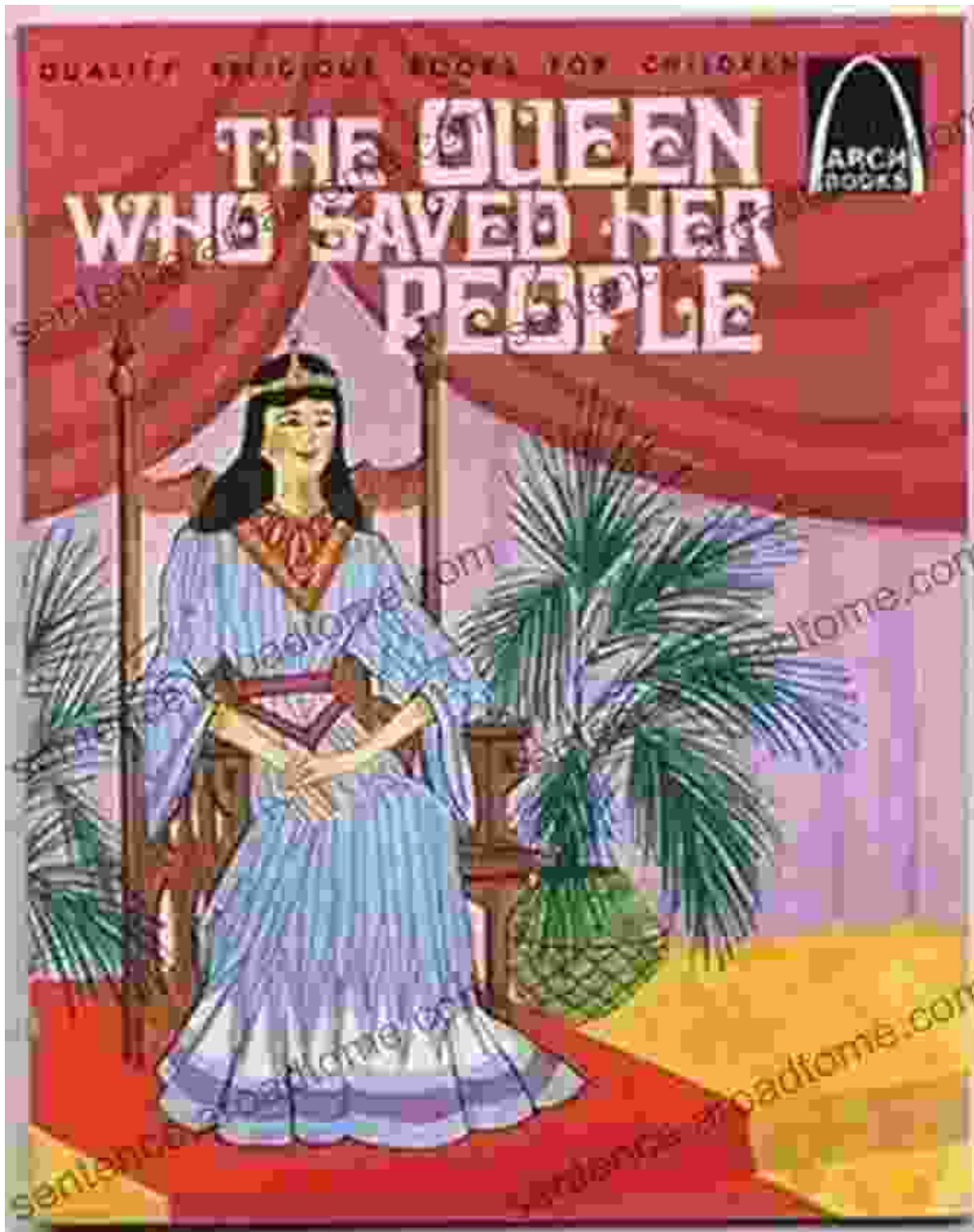
Footnote:

Mary Magdalene was one of Jesus' most devoted disciples. She was present at his crucifixion and was the first to witness his resurrection.

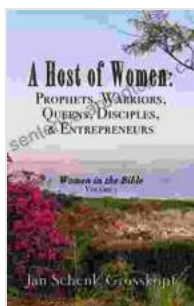

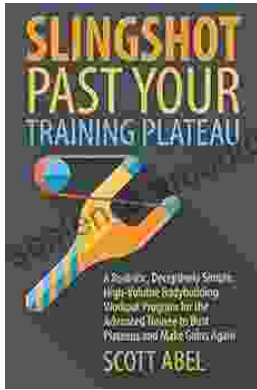
